

Parents,

As of right now there are a lot of uncertainties due to COVID-19. We are putting specific precautionary measures in place such as:

- Disinfecting the car in between drives
- Limiting outside contact while driving
- Proper Hand Sanitization prior to driving

We understand the many concerns that have come about with COVID-19 and want you to understand that enrolling in the fall driver's ed class is completely optional. If you are uncomfortable with the risks of COVID-19 we respect that, and we ask that you do not sign up to take driver's ed this fall. We are going to continue to offer this service in hopes that the students can work toward the goal of safely completing driver's education. We do ask that if your child is showing any symptoms of not feeling well that they do not come to class or drive until they are 100% healthy.

We ask that if you refrain from voluntarily signing up to drive or attending class if you have:

- Traveled Outside of the US in the past 14 days
- Have had any known contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or is currently

being tested within the past 14 days (Contact means being within 6 feet of them for at least 10 minutes)

- Any of the following symptoms:
 - o Cough
 - o Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - o Fatigue
 - o Muscle or body aches
 - o Headache
 - o New loss of taste or smell
 - o Sore throat
 - o Congestion or runny nose
 - o Nausea or vomiting
 - o Diarrhea
